## Features

	Description
<b>MP3 Format</b>	The music files in this library are "MP3" files (MPEG-1 Audio Layer 3), which is a digital audio encoding format common for consumer audio storage, as well as a de facto standard encoding for the transfer and playback of music on digital audio players.
<b>Player Software</b>	MP3 player software must be installed on your computer in order to listen to MP3 files on your sound card and speakers. If you surf the web regularly for music files, you probably already have a MP3 player installed on your computer.
<b>Player Devices</b>	Many electronic players, such as the Apple iPod, can play MP3 files that are loaded into the memory/storage of the device.
<b>Sound Quality</b>	The MP3 compression algorithm is designed to greatly reduce the amount of data required to represent the audio recording and still sound like a faithful reproduction of the original uncompressed audio for most listeners. An MP3 file that is created using the mid-range bit rate settings will result in a file that is typically about 1/10th the size of the audio CD file created from the original audio source.

## Installation

- **ZIP install:** If your MP3 Library was delivered in a ZIP file, unzip the entire contents of the zip file to your hard disk, then click the file 'index.html' to open the MP3 Library.
- **CD/DVD install:** If your MP3 Library was delivered on a CD or DVD, insert the CD/DVD into your drive and Windows will automatically autorun the MP3 Library in your browser; on other platforms (or if autorun fails to start) click the file 'index.html' to open the MP3 Library.
- **USB Drive install:** If your MP3 Library was delivered on a USB drive, insert the USB drive into a connector port on your computer, open the USB drive folder, and click the file 'index.html' to open the MP3 Library.
- **Hard Disk:** You may copy the MP3 Library files onto your hard disk for more convenient access and faster response; copy all of the files and the entire folder structure.
- **MP3 Files:** Direct access to the MP3 files is provided by opening the folder 'mp3' in the root folder of each hymnal's installation.

## System Requirements

- Use MS Internet Explorer or Firefox browsers on Windows systems; use Safari on the Mac.
- MP3 player software is required to play the MP3 files on your computer; free players include Apple Quicktime and Microsoft Windows Media Player; both are available for free download.
