Installation

- **ZIP install:** If your Multi-Media Hymn Library was delivered in a ZIP file, unzip the contents of the zip file to your hard disk, then click the file 'index.html' to open the library in your browser.
- **CD/DVD install:** If your library was delivered on a CD or DVD, insert the CD/DVD into your drive and Windows will automatically autorun the library in your browser; on other platforms (or if autorun fails to start) click the file 'index.html' to open the library in your browser.
- **Hard Disk:** You may copy the Multi-Media Hymn Library files onto your hard disk for more convenient access and faster response; copy all of the files and the entire folder structure.
- **File Access:** Direct access to the slide, video, sheet music, PowerPoint, midi, (ASCII) text, and MP3 files is provided by opening the correspondingly-named folder in the root folder of each hymnal's installation.

System Requirements

- Use MS Internet Explorer or Firefox browsers on Windows systems; use Safari on the Mac.
- The 'Adobe Flash Player' and 'Adobe Reader' required to view the videos and sheet music files. Both browser plug-ins are available at no cost from Adobe, www.adobe.com.
- MP3 and midi player software is required to play the music files.
- Microsoft PowerPoint software is required to open the PowerPoint files.
- Any text editor can open the ASCII text files.
